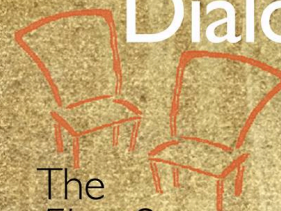

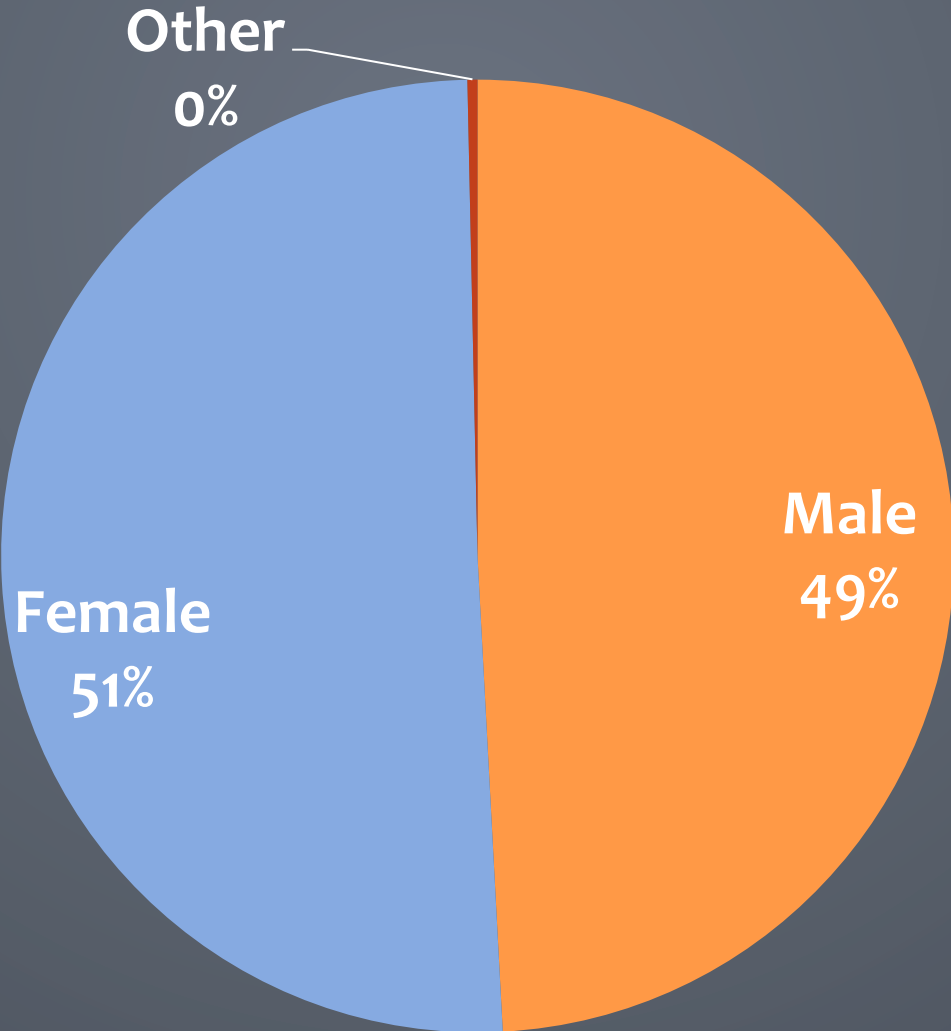

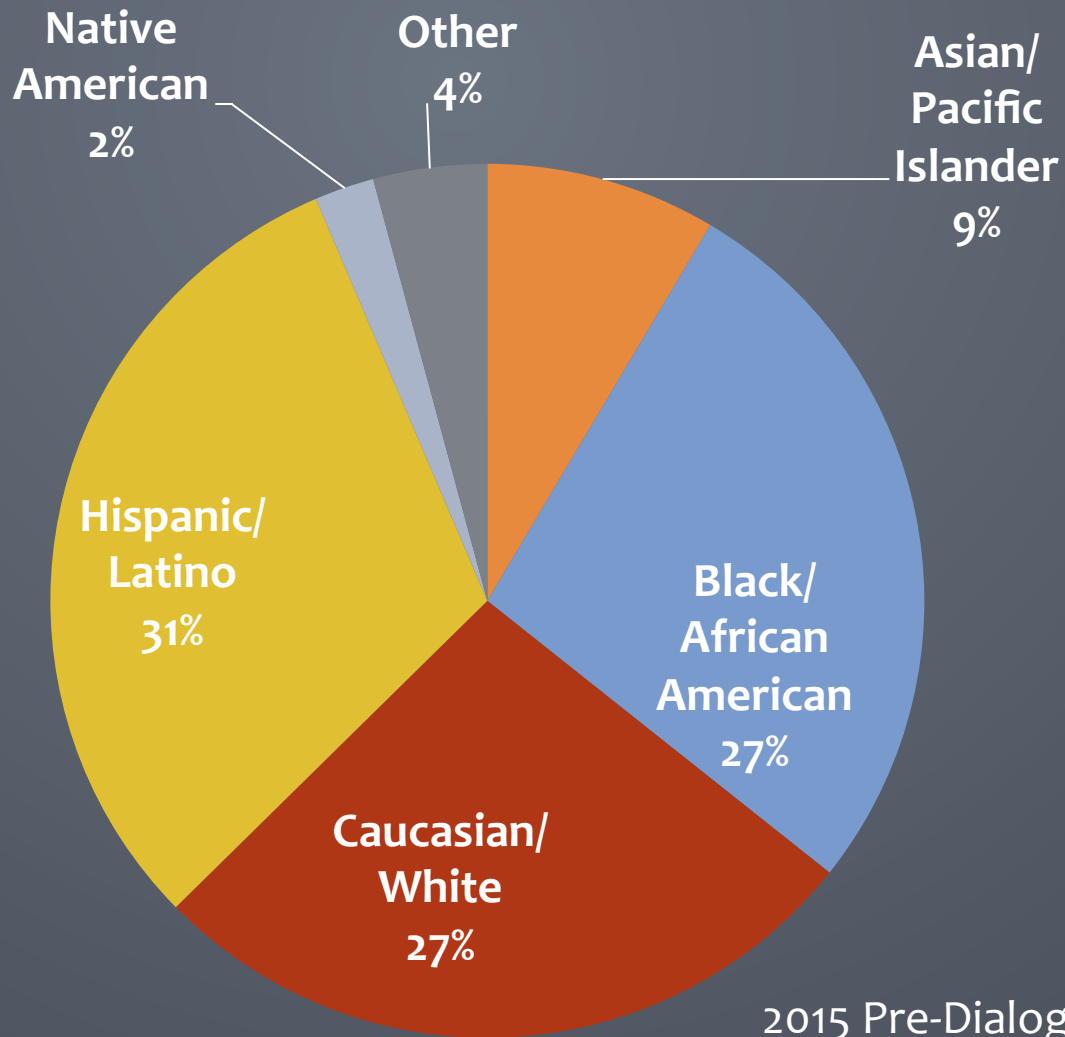
GENDER

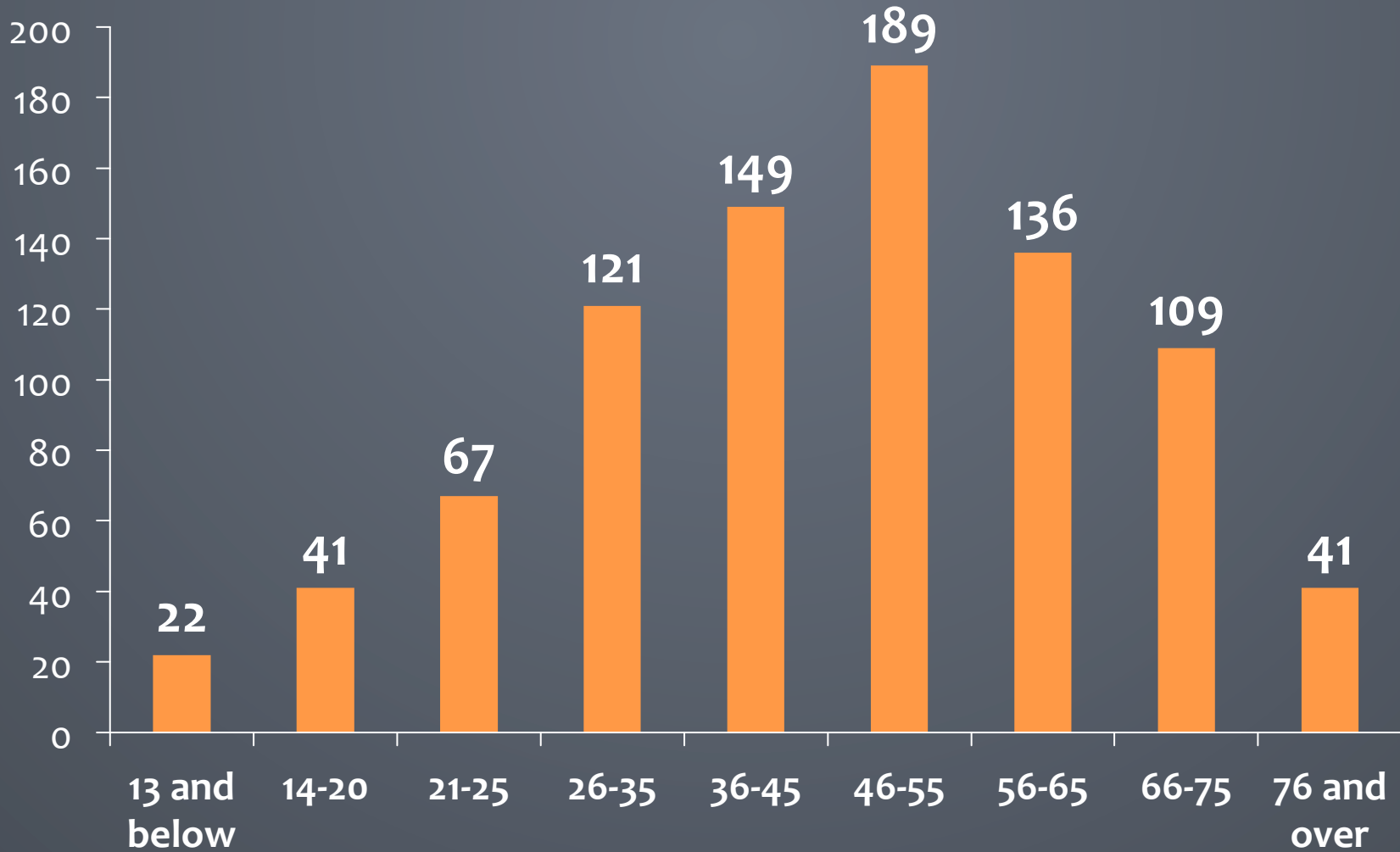
ETHNICITY

(Respondents allowed to pick more than one choice)



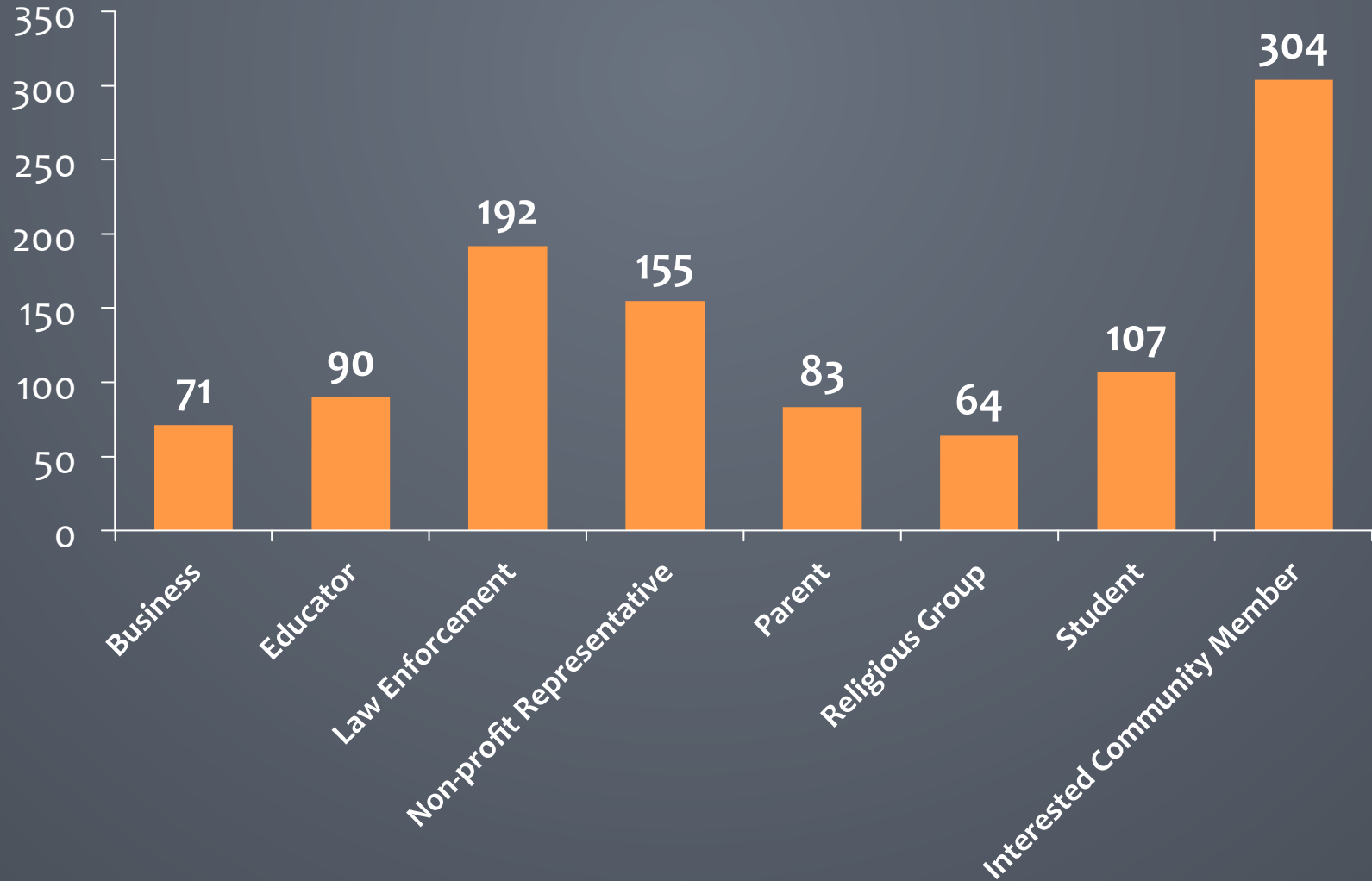

AGE

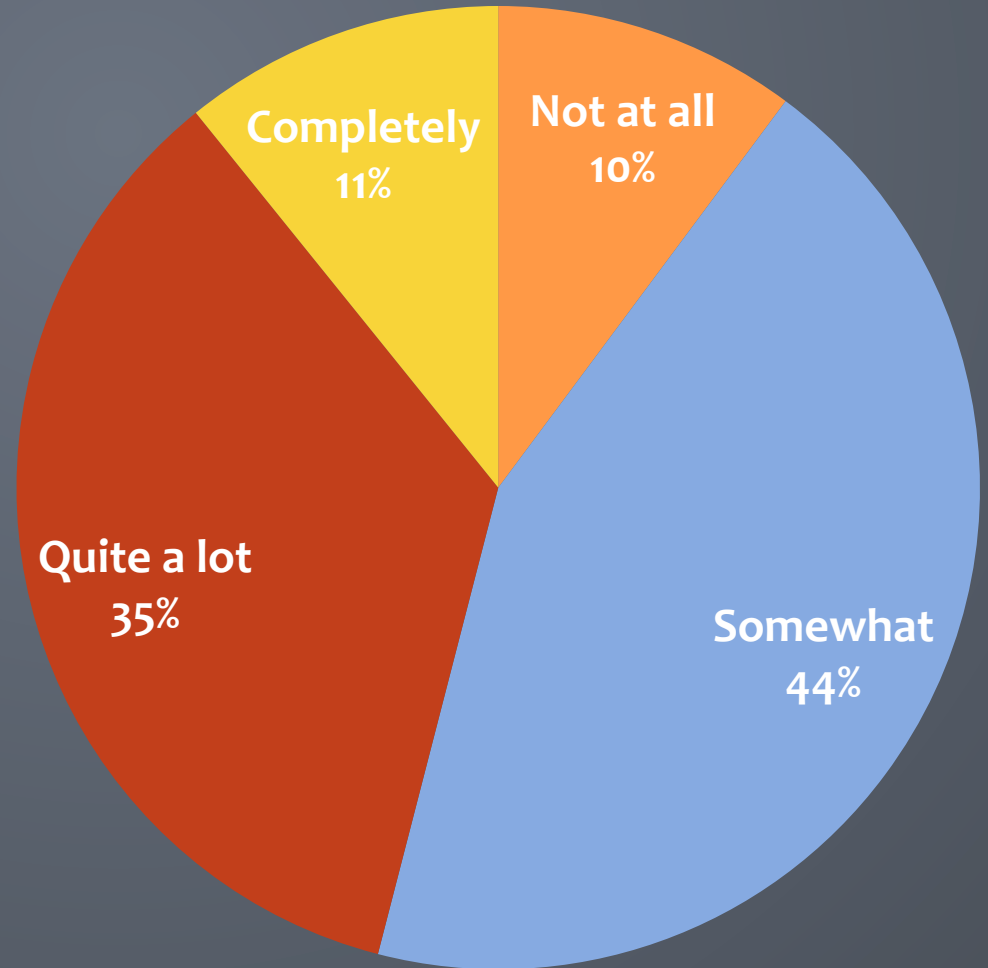


AFFILIATION

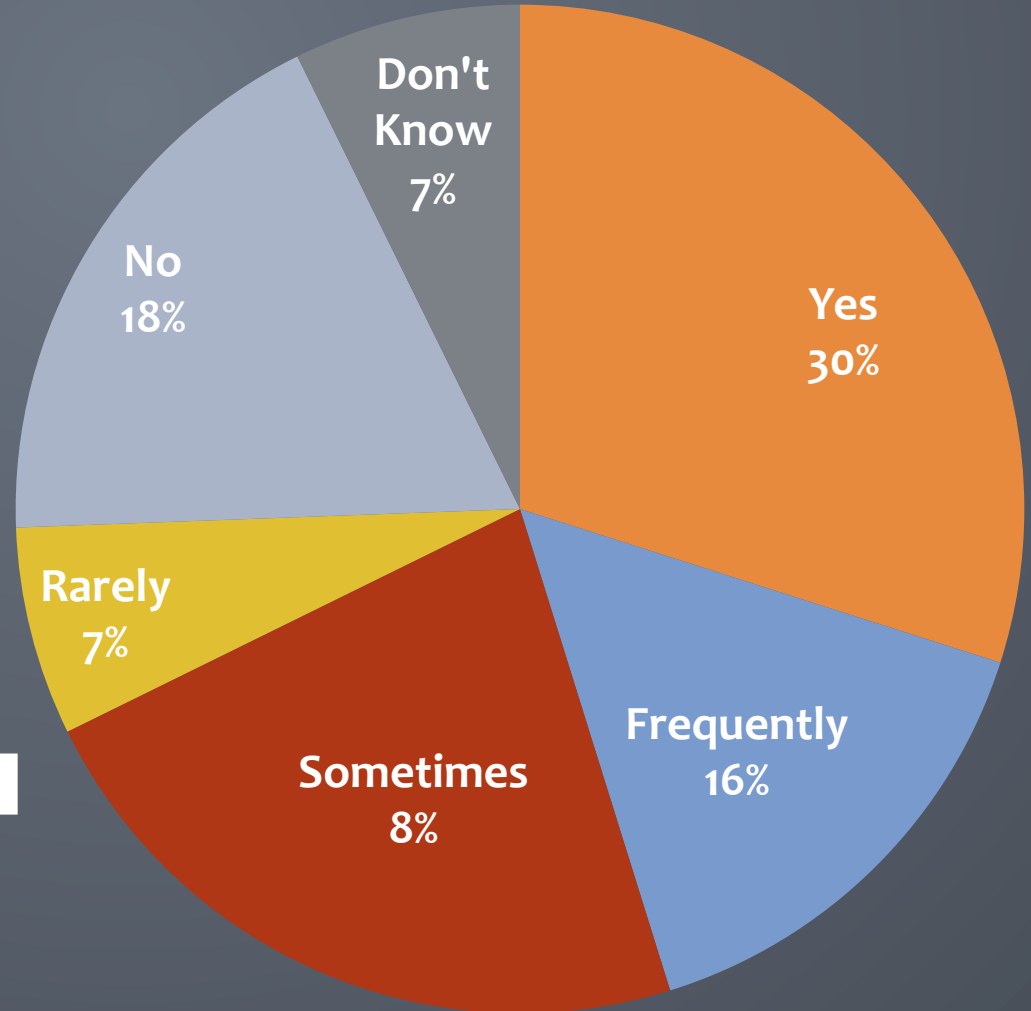

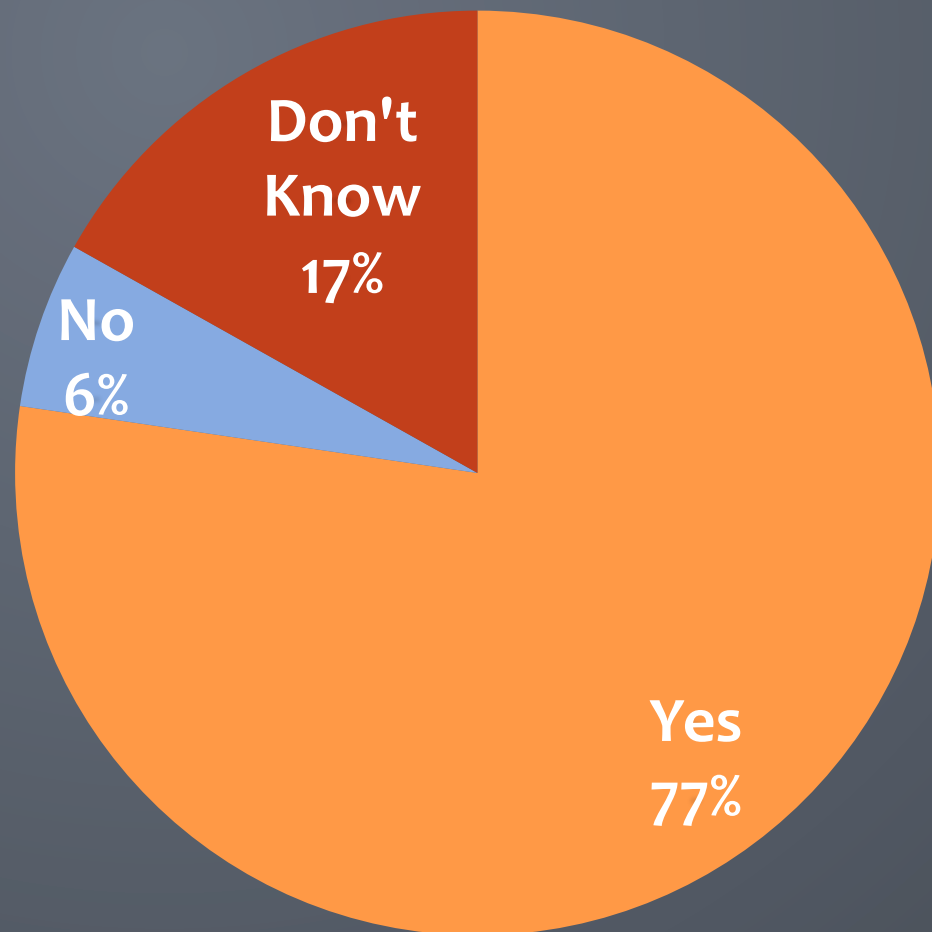

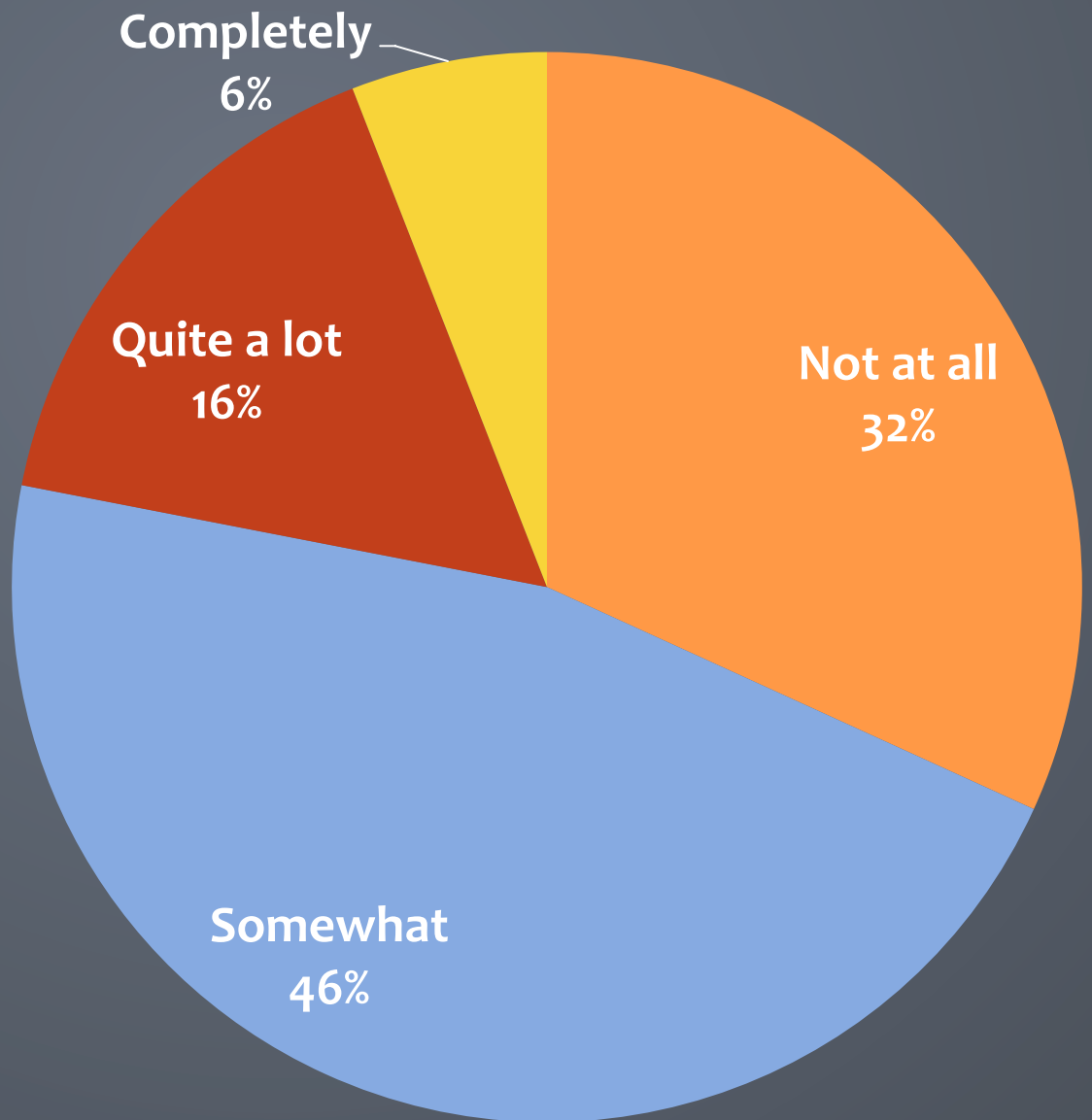

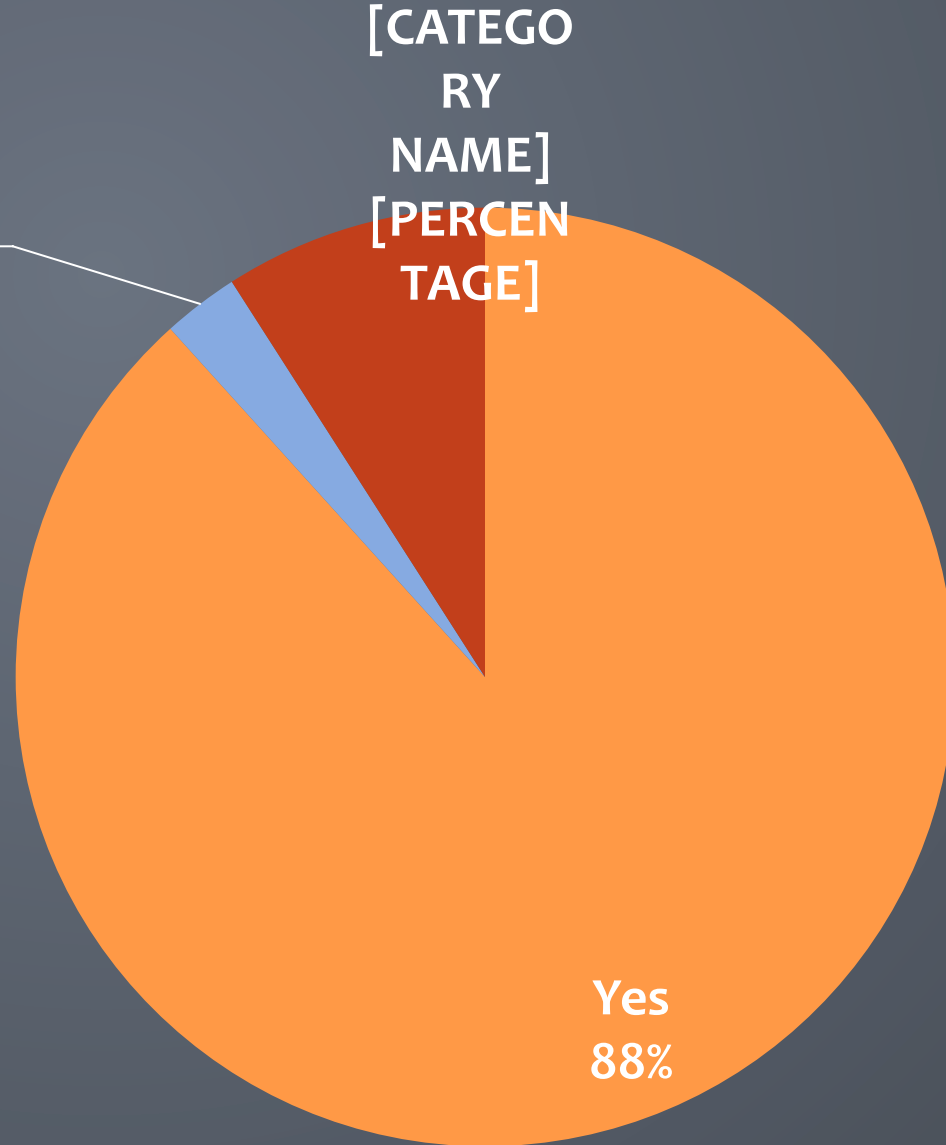

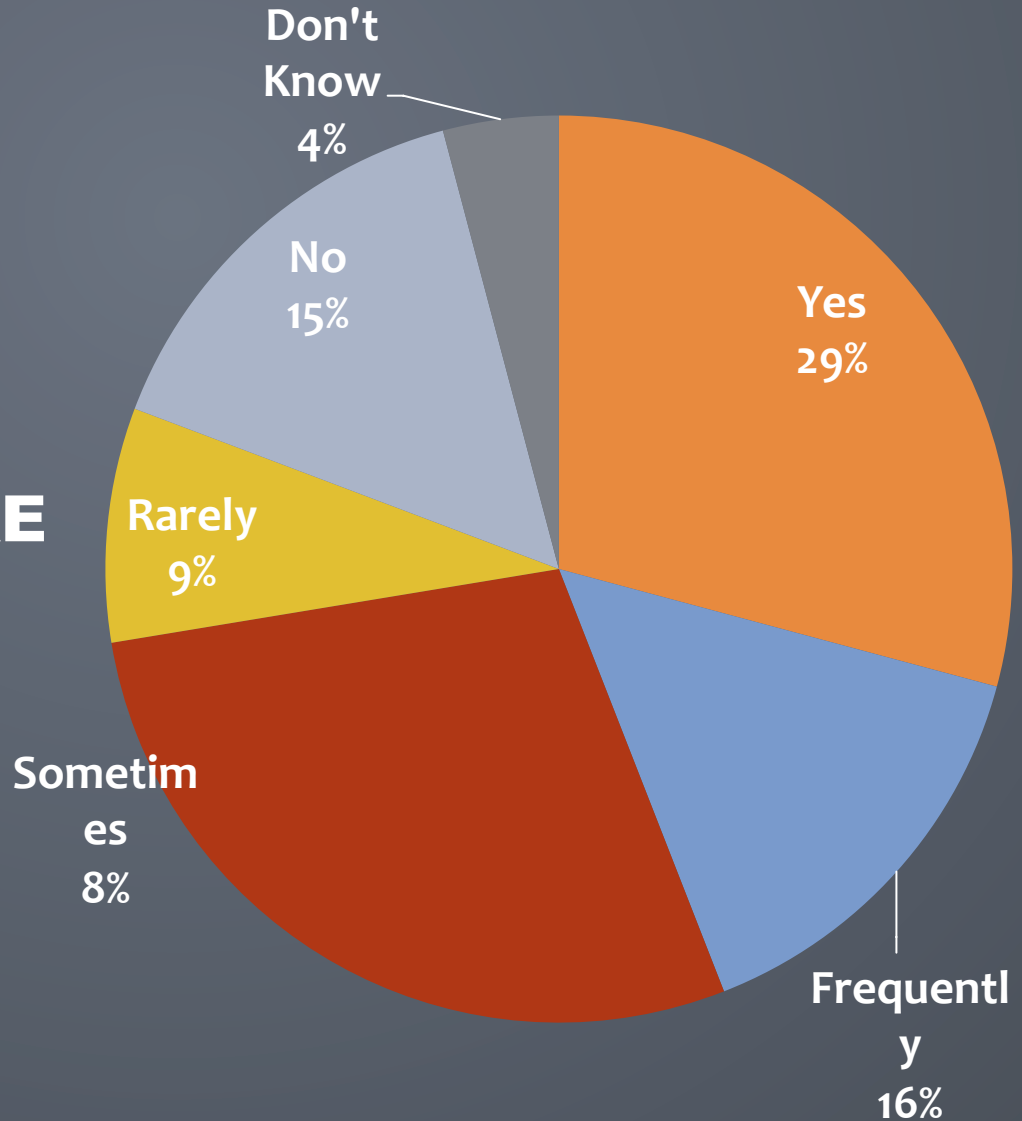
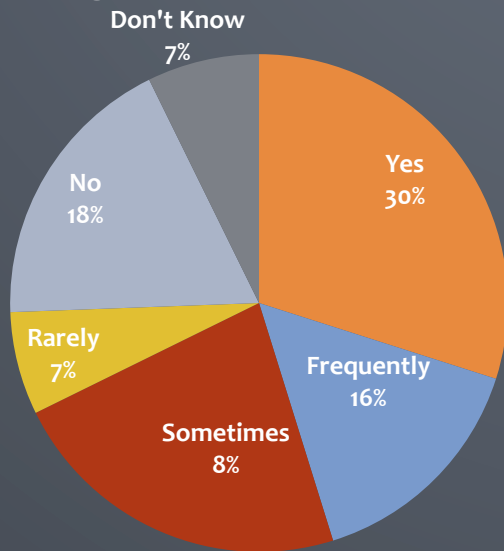

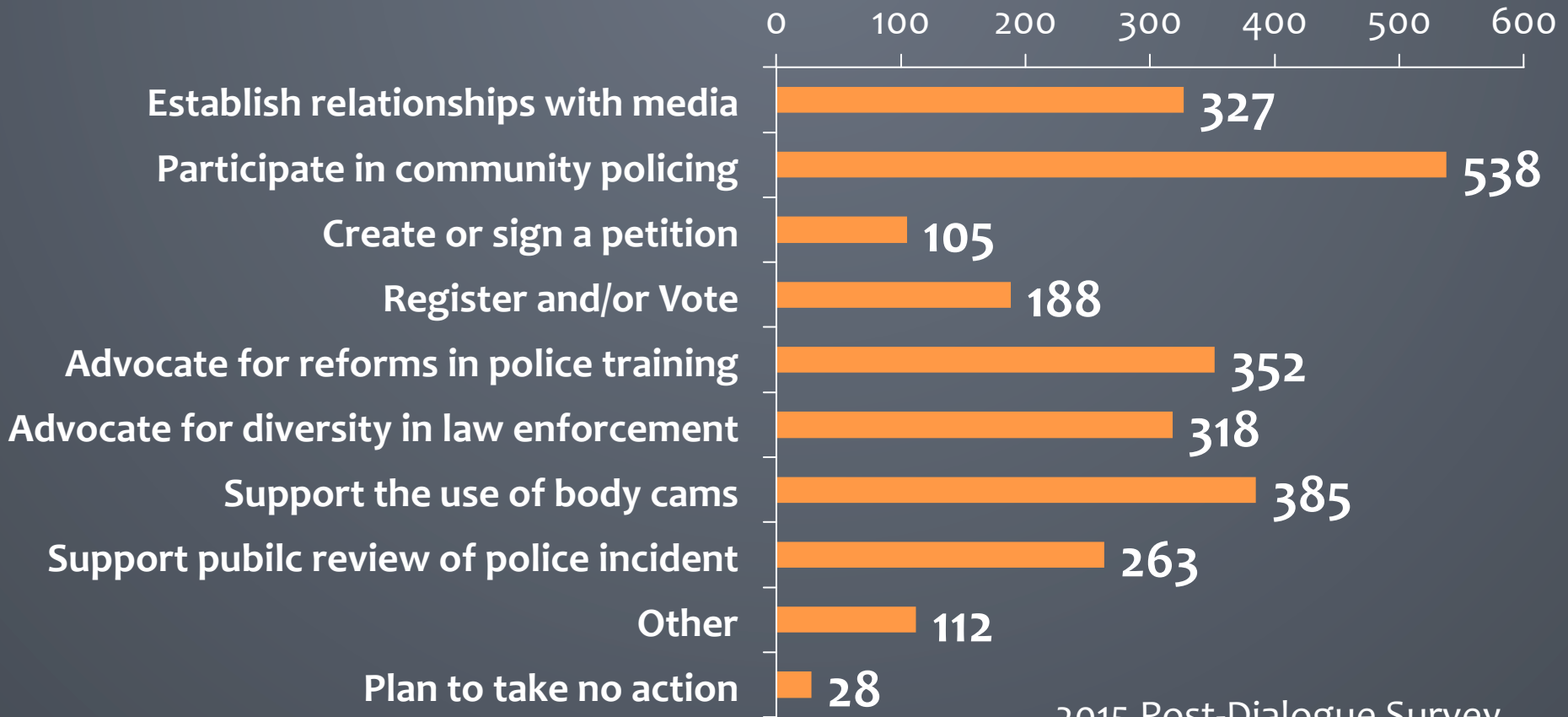
